Our current project is a youth camp for fall 2009 in Eastern Ontario, Canada. The camp will host up to 80 young people from the region and expose them to the concepts of teamwork, caring for others and the environment, giving back to individuals and community, leadership, and healthy living through exercise.

I2P is partnering with Evolve Tours to host this event. Evolve has extensive experience in youth programming and leadership and together the two organizations will provide an experience that will start the process of equipping a generation of global problem solvers to achieve environmental and human sustainability.

Activities at the two-day camp will consist of inspirational group talks and one on one interaction with i2P founder Ray Zahab along with other i2P athletes and ambassadors. The topics of these discussions will focus on achieving the impossible and believing that we can make a difference. Campers will also be challenged both physically and mentally in team building and leadership exercises. There will be trekking/orienteering challenges where an appreciation for the environment is emphasized. In the evening youth will engage in group discussions on the topics of social issues facing the world's youth today. Campers will also identify and discuss issues facing their communities. Furthermore they will be encouraged to identify strategies and solutions for these issues. Each camper will be introduced to a world of healthy living through exercise and the benefits of caring for yourself in order to help others.

Upon completion of the camp youth will become i2P Youth Ambassadors! Each camper will be provided with tools and resources to head out into the world with confidence that they too can achieve the impossible!
