


# HOW TO USE i2P EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES IN YOUR CLASSROOM!

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#### **CLASS TIME COMMITMENT LEVELS**

Depending on the time you have with the students as well as how much time you want to spend on the I2P curriculum, there are several possibilities that can all be effective. The following are examples of how the curriculum can be leveraged in your classes:

#### LEVEL 1

- Class follows the live feeds
- Class does a financial literacy activity together
- Students choose an assignment from the curriculum and present accordingly

### LEVEL 2

- Teacher emails Youth Ambssadors with some student questions prior to expedition
- Class follows the live feeds
- Class follows some/all of the financial literacy curriculum activities
- Students choose an assignment from the curriculum and present accordingly





- Teacher contacts the Youth Ambassadors prior to expedition to set up live in-class Skype calls. Students prepare questions for the calls.
- Class does pre-expedition activities in class (view videos on web site)
- Class follows the live feeds
- Class follows all of the financial literacy curriculum activities
- Students choose an assignment from the curriculum and present accordingly
- Students re-connect with one, several, or all Youth Ambssadors with follow-up questions
- A thematic art project is included within the unit
- Class invites other classes in the school to participate in the i2P Run Challenge program




